As a Match Control Team Member, we may reasonably expect you to:

- Check the scoring system is functioning correctly daily and feedback on any issues
- Print umpire sheets and orders of play
- Put matches on court/off court (electronically)
- Produce daily reports through tournament software (if required)
- Liaise with Match Control to ensure a coordinated approach
- Volunteer during evenings and weekends.

When do I volunteer?

- There is a selection of shifts for you to indicate your availability.
- We hope that you will be able to volunteer with us for at least three shifts throughout the event so that we can each get the most from the volunteering experience.
- All shift timings are correct at the time of recruitment. However some changes may occur in the build-up and during the event itself. We will share any changes with as much notice as possible and discuss this with you.
- Sunday shifts are only available to volunteers who have volunteered earlier during the Championships.
